Speed limit is 5MPH. Please be safe and use caution when driving through the campgrounds.

Quiet hours are from 10:00PM-7:00AM. The use of generators and noisy equipment are not permitted during these times. Stereo/TV volume should be kept low enough not to disturb your neighbors.

US Mail, FedEx and UPS deliver to the FamCamp office only. Mail can be picked up Mon-Fri 0800-1600 at the FamCamp office.

Free standing canopies ARE NOT allowed on any RV site with the exception of screened canopies.

Checkout time is 1100 daily.

You may have up to 2 vehicles on your site not counting the RV. Cars, Trucks, Boats, cargo trailers, Utility trailers and watercraft trailers count as a vehicle. Motorcycles, Tow Dolly's, Golf Carts and scooters are exempt.

Boats over 20 feet hull length are not allowed in the FamCamp. Boats under 20 feet must fit on your site and count as 1 of your 2 vehicles.

Campsites areas must be kept neat, clean of trash and debris at all times to include, but not limited to, cigarette butts, bottle caps and dog droppings. Toys, bicycles and other items must be neatly stored and not be left scattered about.

Clotheslines are prohibited.

Porch furniture is allowed as long as it does not obstruct grass cutting, foot or vehicular traffic or present a cluttered appearance. Satellite dishes are permitted. No poles or stakes can be driven into ground, tripods with no stakes are acceptable. All other personal items (ladders, hoses, tools, storage containers etc.) are to be stored out of sight.

Wooden or homemade steps for gaining access to the RV are prohibited. Contact the office if these are needed due to a disability.

NO OPEN FIRES ARE ALLOWED INCLUDING FIRE PITS. This includes no TIKI torches or any device that requires an open flame to operate. Propane fire pits are allowed. Gas and charcoal grills are allowed.

Pets must be kept on a leash at ALL times. You must pick up and dispose of pet waste in the dumpster.

Pets cannot be left outside unattended at any time. Guests may set up a temporary fence for their pets not to exceed 48 inches in height. Owners must be physically present (not inside the RV) when pets are in the fenced area. The same applies to a dog clipped to a lead. The owner must be present and outside with the dog.

Pets are not allowed into the Recreation center unless seeking shelter during severe weather. Service dogs are allowed into the facility.

Cardboard/Trash dumpsters are located at the entrance of camp.. The green cardboard recycle trailer is for cardboard and Aluminum cans ONLY. All cans must be bagged before placing into the trailer.
